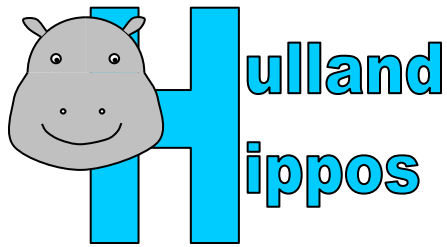


2022 Winter Newsletter
