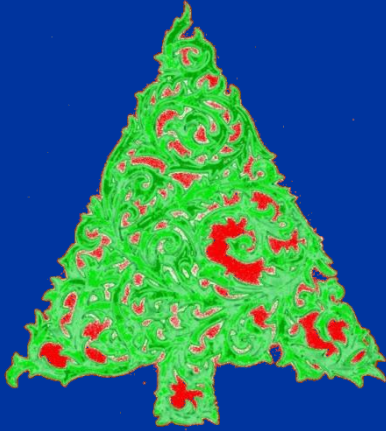


HOGNASTON WINTER FESTIVAL 2019
