Soul Spark is a six-session course that delves into some of the riches of the Christian tradition of prayer to enable a deeper and healthier spirituality.

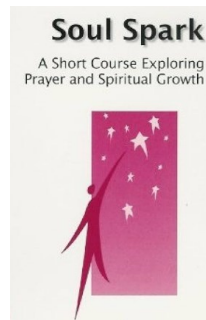
